Cairns Wake Park Waiver

I, the undersigned participant, does hereby acknowledge and fully understands that activities at Cairns Wake Park are strenuous outdoor physical activities that requires strength, stamina and fitness. Waterskiing, kneeboarding and wakeboarding are inherently dangerous activities and can be extremely strenuous on the body

I, the undersigned, further understands that INJURIES can, and do, occur

In using the Wake Park I acknowledge, understand and accept this risk of injury to myself, my friends & their families.

People with heart or health problems, pre-existing injuries, especially knees, ankles, shoulders, back and neck, as well as pregnant women are advised they should not use the Wake Park

I, the undersigned understands that I am only permitted to use the Cairns Wake Park on the following conditions

1. That I agree to follow all the Wake Park safety rules listed below, and outlined in the safety video

- It is mandatory for ALL patrons to wear a **BOUYANCY VEST** and **HELMET** at all times, that fits tightly and securely.
- As a beginner or inexperienced rider I agree to stay away from all obstacles, and other swimmers/riders in the water, and to let go of the handle if close to one and/or out of control
- Go between the 2 buoys at each corner (If not the rope goes slack and you are pulled off your board)
 - Let go at the exit buoys between the last 2 towers
- If you fall, look behind you for approaching riders and bouncing handles. Clear the area immediately and swim quickly and strongly to the nearest shoreline or exit area
- If the machine stops, let go and swim to shore, then walk back to the start. Do not hold on and attempt to restart.

2. If choosing to use obstacles, rails and kickers I understand and acknowledge that participating in any slider and kicker activities can bear certain anticipated and unanticipated risks, which could result in INJURY, DEATH, ILLNESS or DISEASE, PHYSICAL and MENTAL DAMAGE to myself, to my property or to other parties or their property.

Do not use any rails, kickers, sliders or obstacles without first talking to a qualified staff member

3. That I agree that I voluntarily choose to participate in these activities on the property and hereby personally and freely assume all risks in connection with these activities, for any injury, death or damage.

4. That I agree to accept those risks and all liability for the consequences of my actions

5. That I agree that I will not make any claim for personal injury, death or damage (including property damage) or other loss and that I indemnify Cairns Wake Park for any liability occurring as a result of or in connection with my participation in the activities on the Property

Accommodation suggestions

Accommodation in the CBD - Budget; There are rooms at Global Backpackers being held for us which is directly above Rattle and Hum - a great night out for tea!

There are private queen rooms available which would suit families. There are also dorms with a private bathroom and facilities if bunking in with a few riders is more for you. If this is for you, please call Global Backpackers directly Ph: 07 4031 1545 and mention you are a part of the wakeboarding competition for 10% off. Children are accommodated here also. Global is a great location, situated in the CBD, right on the esplanade where the nightlife, restaurants and lagoon area are all at your fingertips. www.globalbackpackers.com.au/cairns/waterfront/

We would suggest booking other options close to the CBD if you prefer to be able to access restaurants etc after hours. The best deals are available on booking.com, trivago.com etc.

Accommodation closer to the Park - Budget; Lake Placid Rainforest Retreat. It is located 5 mins from the Wake Park. If you are only here to wakeboard and travel to and from the park fast, this is an option. There are cabins available at the Lake Placid Retreat which are a budget style choice or if you are travelling with friends. Ph: 07 4039 2509 to make your booking. www.lakeplacidtouristpark.com

There are also Airbnb houses closer to the park (our suburb is Smithfield) and to the north (northern beaches – eg. Trinity Beach) which are also within 5-10 mins North of the park. There are local buses that run frequently which would be your best transport other than Uber.

Please be aware that due to the event being held during tourist season and school holidays, accommodation in Cairns is filling fast so book in as soon as possible to avoid missing out.
