Conditions of Membership

I understand that management reserves the right to amend the hours of operation, services offered, fees & charges, membership terms and conditions in accordance with the changing requirements of the business.

1. Membership

Your membership is an arrangement between you and Cairns Wake Park and will be validated at first skiing session. As a member of Cairns Wake Park you agree to conduct yourself with appropriate behavior and treat others with respect. Foul language and inappropriate behavior will not be tolerated. Cairns Wake Park management is not obliged to give reasons for any decision it makes to suspend, terminate or restrict your Membership or to reject your request to become a member. You must advise a staff member if you are injured or if there is any change to your health that may impact your ability to continue your membership. A membership cancellation form is required to be complete in order to terminate your membership agreement – please obtain from reception.

2. Members Access

A Payment will be charged for your membership key tag when you sign up for a membership. You are required to present your key tag to the reception and collect a wristband each day you participate at Cairns Wake Park. At no stage are you permitted to give your membership tag to non-members. In the instance of this instant dismissal applies and your membership will be terminated. If a key tag is lost or misplaced, a replacement will be charged at a cost to you. To use the wake park, your account must be valid and up to date. Direct Debit members only: overdue payments can be made by calling Cairns Wake Park.

3. Equipment

While participating in cable watersports at Cairns Wake Park you are required to wear a coast guard approved type PFD 3 jacket and a suitable helmet. Approved life jackets and helmets are available for hire from reception. Alternatively you can bring your own, or purchase your own through the pro shop. Using the obstacles at Cairns Wake Park is at your own risk which can potentially include injuries to yourself and damage to your equipment. You are required to use an approved wakeboard only on the obstacles. A board can be hired from reception, you can bring your own though it must be approved by staff, or you can purchase your own from our pro shop.

4. Membership absences

Injury related absences must be recorded within 3 days to reception via phone call or email in order for your membership to be put on hold. Management has the right to refuse a membership hold with no reason. It is in the owners or manager's discretion to extend your membership should the injury be of a more serious nature.

5. Cable use

Riding without a wristband will not be permitted at any time. "Riding Doubles" creates an added risk and is totally at the operator's discretion. Members must abide by the rules regarding this practice to minimize these risks and failure to abide by the following rules will result in a ban from riding at Cairns Wake Park. During a said ban there will be no refund or extension of membership. The rider on the handle must acknowledge the operators signal before the second rider is loaded. Riders must not hit the same obstacle at the same time. Riders must not jump or trick over their riding partner. If one rider falls the other must immediately let go of the handle.

6. Availability of facilities

Repair and maintenance of facilities and/or acts of weather or nature and other occurrences may make it necessary for the park to change hours of use or restrict the use of the facility or to close the park temporarily. The temporary unavailability of all or any part of the Facilities shall not entitle Members to a refund of any portion of their membership fees or dues payments. Cairns Wake Park reserves the right, in its sole and absolute discretion, to modify operation of any or all of the facilities, to sell or otherwise dispose of the facility, and to make any other changes in the terms and conditions of membership or the facility available for use by Members. Use of the facility may be restricted or reserved from time to time as determined by management and may extend privileges of the business and the right to use the facility to such other persons and upon such terms as management may from time to time prescribe.

7. Members board storage facility

Members have the opportunity to leave their equipment at Cairns Wake Park in the designated member's area. There are reserved racks for specific members. The area must be left clean and tidy at all times. You must only use your own equipment and using other member's equipment is not allowed. Leaving equipment at the designated members area is purely voluntary and at owners risk. Cairns Wake Park accepts no responsibility for lost, damaged or stolen equipment.

Acceptance of Risk and Responsibility

- I may be physically or mentally injured, impaired, maimed or killed;
- I have read conditions 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 and 7 and understand all circumstances;
- Other participants and members of the wake park may act dangerously or with lack of skill;
- Conditions may be hazardous and may vary without warning or predictability;
- My property may be damaged, lost or destroyed;
- I understand the risks and rules of "Riding doubles";
- I understand that failure to abide by any of the following rules will result in a ban from riding at Cairns Wake Park;
- Memberships cannot be transferred or sold to another person;
- I sign to say that I have watched and understood the rules and implications of the wake park safety video.

My participation is purely voluntary and subject to accepting these conditions.
